POS Button Caption Carriage Returns

This function was introduced in Idealpos 7.1 Build 1 and allows you to control which portion of text in a POS screen button should appear on a new line by using of a special Carriage Return character "~".

This feature has now been added to the Handheld app so that it follows the same behaviour as Idealpos and displays text within a button on a new line when the Carriage Return character "~" exists.

Note that due to screen size restrictions on smaller tablet devices, you may notice that some buttons which show text in their entirety on an Idealpos POS screen will be shortened with "..." on smaller mobile devices, especially when using the Carriage Return character to move text to the next line.

When using small phone size devices such as an iPod Touch or iPhone, Carriage Returns will simply act in the same way as a standard space character and trigger a space to appear between text.

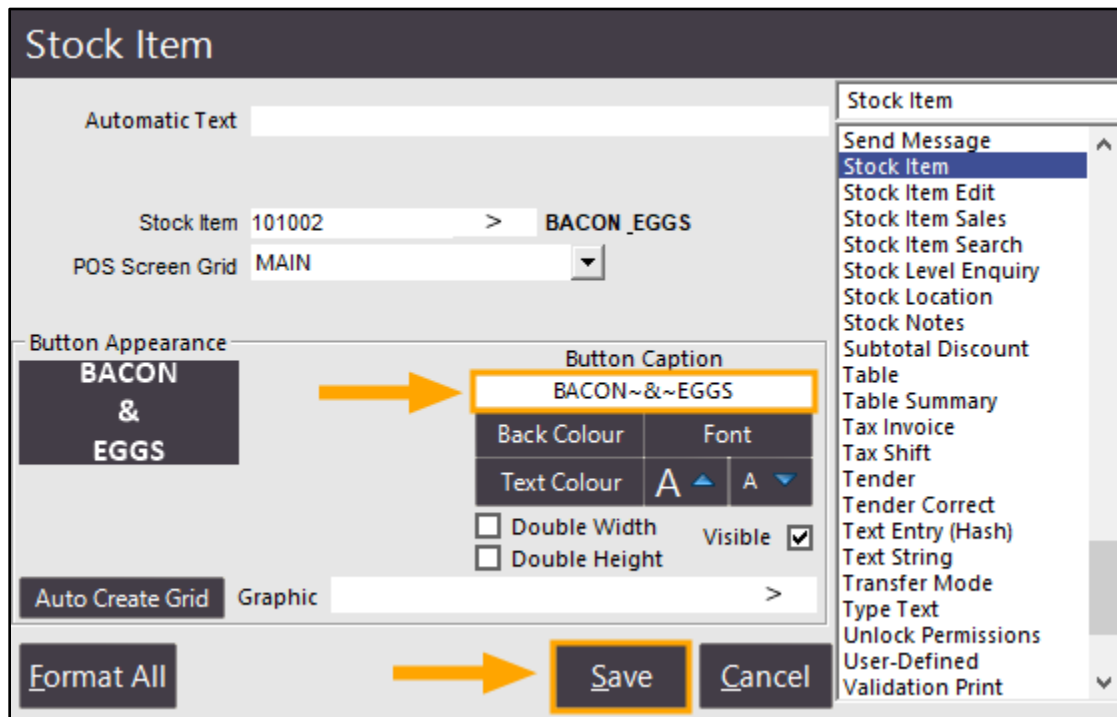
To use this function, go to: Setup > POS Screen > POS Screen Setup > Select POS Screen Layout > Buttons

Either select an existing button on the POS screen which you want to include Carriage Returns in the caption or create a new button.

The below example shows modifying an existing button.

Click on the button, then in the button caption, enter a tilde "~" symbol anywhere that you'd like to have the text move onto a new line. The button appearance displayed on the left-hand side of the screen will update on-the-fly as you make your change.

Once you have made the change, press the "Save" button and the change will be visible in the POS Screen Layout.

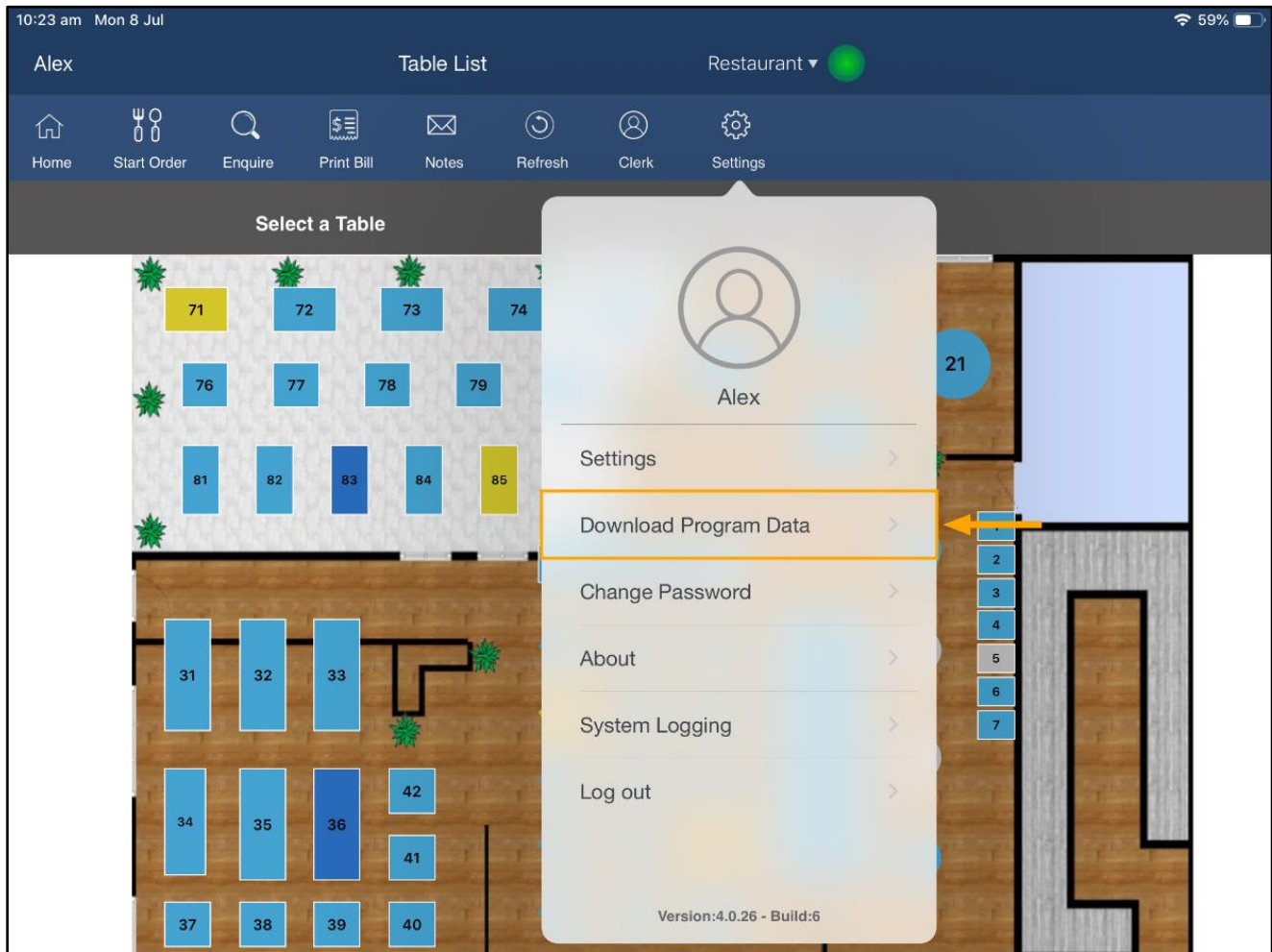


Close the POS screen layout and the change to the button will be applied.

Repeat the above process for any other buttons that require changing.

Once complete, you may Download Program Data from the Handheld App running on a mobile device.
On the mobile device, go to: Settings > Download Program Data



After the Program Data finishes downloading, select a table from the Table Map and press "Start Order".
Finally, select the POS screen tab which contains the button which you updated above.
The button will be displayed in accordance with the carriage return character.
